## Parking in downtown Clarkesville....

You may recall from information included in the last newsletter that the City of Clarkesville has passed an ordinance declaring that the parking lot directly in front of the shops on both sides of the square be reserved for customers. This means that we need to park elsewhere.

There are two free parking lots relatively nearby. One is between the gazebo and Woods Mercantile. The other is on the other side of the building, down the hill from the Century 21 realty and the Paint-Your-Own studio. (The one exception would be if you have a handicapped sticker and park in a designated handicapped space.)

When the Gallery Committee met the last time, one of the suggestions that was made was that perhaps one of our artists would like to clean the gallery twice a month in lieu of a regular workday.
